hypothermia - the signs/symptoms of hypothermia in adults are similar to those of intoxication: confusion slurred speech **preventing and managing hypothermia and frostbite injury** - epidemiology of hypothermia and frostbite injury. the true incidence of frostbite injury is unknown; however, a recent study has reported an incidence of 20% or more of those involved in skiing and other cold-weather-related sports. in fact, frostbite injury was reported as the most common type of cold injuries. **frostbite and hypothermia - minnesota safety council** - frostbite frostbite occurs when exposed flesh becomes frozen. ice crystals form in the soft tissues due to over-exposure to cold. these ice crystals cause the skin to rupture, killing the cells. the most common areas affected by frostbite are the nose, cheeks, ears, toes and fingers. like hypothermia, frostbite goes through several stages of ... **frostbite & hypothermia frostbite - troop 283** - all other frostbite requires medical attention as soon as possible. first-aid steps for frostbite are as follows: 1. check for hypothermia get emergency medical help if you suspect hypothermia. signs and symptoms of hypothermia include intense shivering, slurred speech, drowsiness and loss of coordination. 2. **with a chance offrostbite - health** - if frostbite is detected, seek medical attention. if there is frostbite but no sign of hypothermia and immediate

medical care is not available, do the following: • move to a warm dry area. • remove wet or tight fitting clothes. • avoid walking on frostbitten toes or feet. • do not rub affected area, this can cause more damage.
